This 2.5km one way route takes you to where the Kaiapoi and Waimakariri rivers meet and is particularly picturesque, so be sure to take your camera! Go east on Raven Quay and follow the stop bank. Look for a trail that goes off to the left as the stop bank sweeps to the right.
