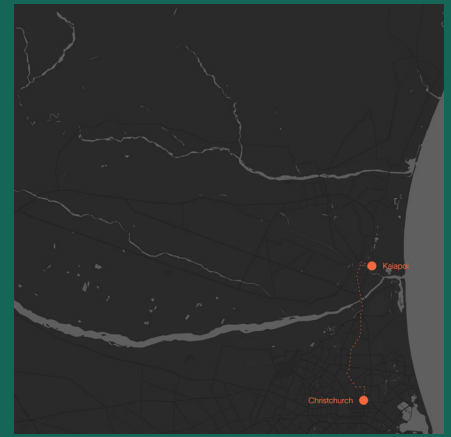


PADDLEBOARD, PICNIC AND PARIS FOR THE WEEKEND
