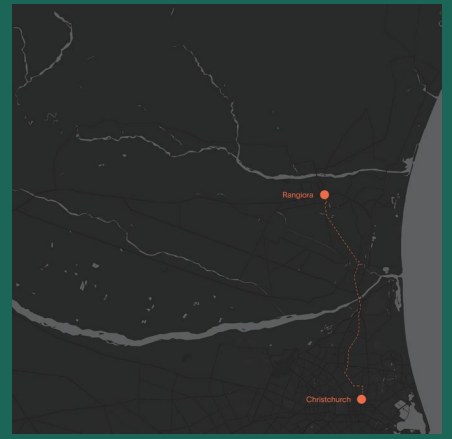


# GIRLS' DAY OUT IN RANGIORA
