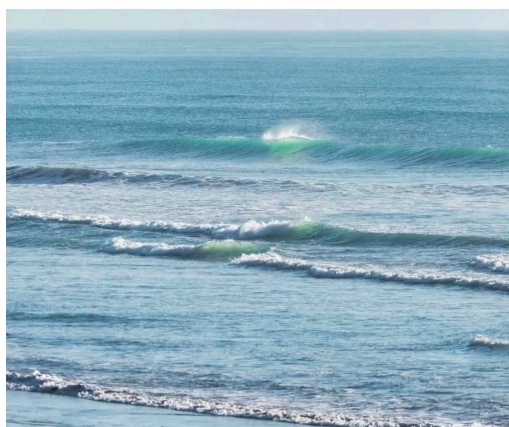


9 SILVERSTREAM DUCK RACE

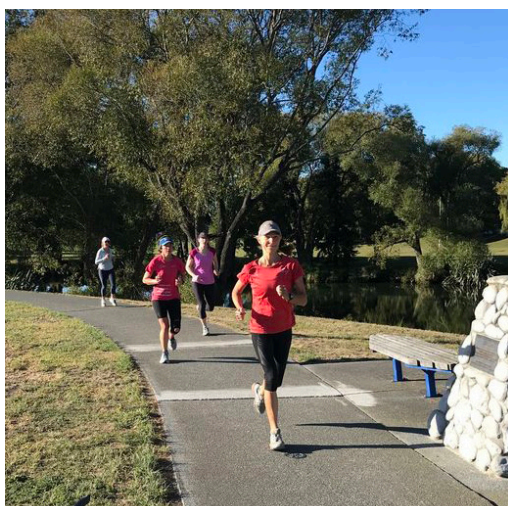


10 SWANNANOA COUNTRY FAIR
