2 VIEW HILL SCHOOL DARK SKY – TAKE BACK THE NIGHT

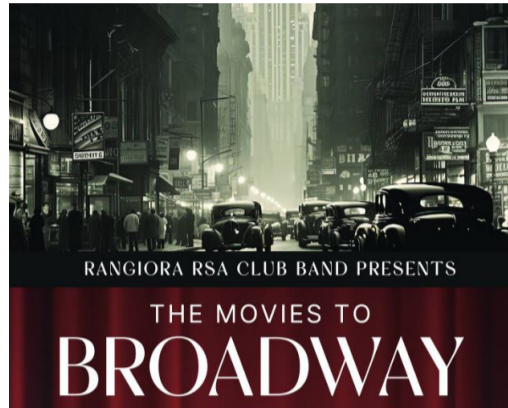
6.30pm – 9.30pm, View Hill School, 496 Island Road, View Hill

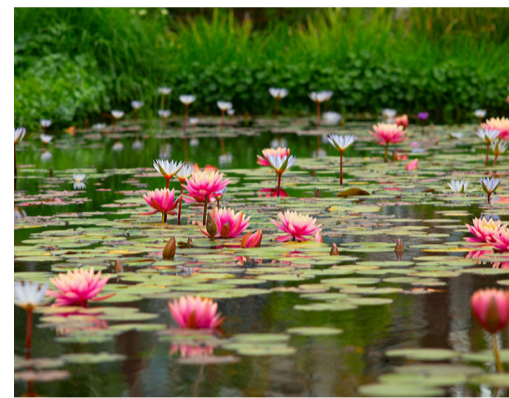


16 THRIVING WITH TAMARIKI
