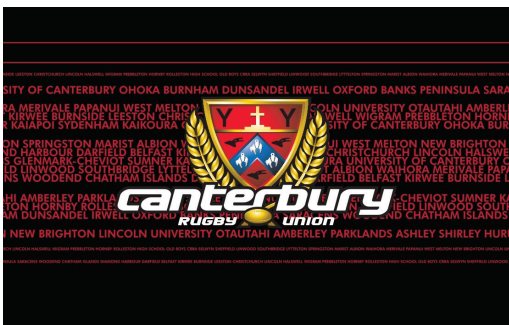


1 JD DUATHLON SERIES

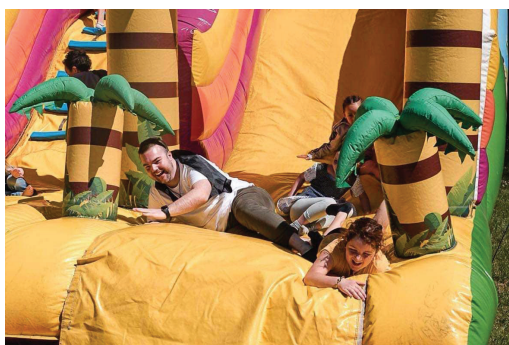


8 CONSERVATION WEEK: TAKING ACTION FOR NATURE
